

Fine specimens in any category seldom attain perfection when permitted to grow wild. Pruning is essential when transplanting. Pruning maintains the general health and vigor of a plant. To be effective, however, pruning must be done properly and must be accomplished with good tools that cut cleanly and do not bruise or tear the growth. The more easily cutting is accomplished, the less harm it can do and the better it will achieve desired results.

There are many guides to proper pruning available. We issue a booklet entitled "How To Prune for Better Flowers, Shrubs, Trees, and Fruit," which retails for 25 cents and is published as a service.

HY-POWER PRUNING SHEARS NO. 908 AND NO. 906

Acclaimed for two qualities not usually found in combination — cutting ease and rugged strength.

Easier cutting is achieved by the anvil construction. The knife blade operates against the soft blade-protecting anvil to give unmatched cutting ability. Ruggedness is achieved by the exclusive, hot-formed Molybdenum alloy tool steel construction. The pistol grip design permits the comfortable application of maximum hand pressure. An easy-to-operate latch permits one handed opening or closing. The strong wedge ground blade is hand edged and honed to knife keenness.

The 906, smaller than the 908 is of the same construction except that the brass anvil is eliminated. It is often chosen for its extra convenience in carrying and by those with small hands and is a favorite choice of women gardeners.

C-6 SPECIAL, CITRUS FRUIT CLIPPERS

Special shears for the florist or greenhouse. Designed for heavy duty cutting as, for example, in the preparation of floral arrangements. One blade serrated.

Designed for light metal cutting. Long handles and relatively short blades provide powerful leverage. Inlaid blade construction lends added keenness and ruggedness. Standard equipment for the florist or greenhouse. Nickel plated blades.



row blades and sharp points permit close cutting in restricted areas. They are unique in construction, with each blade and handle hot drop-forged in one piece from high carbon cutlery steel. Handles are contoured for comfort, offset to prevent knuckle scraping, fitted with a convenient closing catch and finished in red baked enamel.



These qualities are accomplished by a cleverly placed pivot screw, the use of an especially easy, yet positive spring, accurate edge beveling, and the application of proper blade tension from heel to points.

The hand guard and the shape of the handles contribute to comfortable, effortless operation. The hardened blades are nickel plated for rust resistance. Handles are fitted with a convenient closing catch. Easily disassembled for repair if necessary. Red and black baked enamel handles.

NO. 801 WISS "QUICK-TRIM" GRASS SHEARS

All the operating construction features of the No. 700 are included in the No. 801 with the elimination only of the hand guard. Blades are specially shaped to allow close cutting around trees or along walls. Easily disassembled if necessary. Hardened blades are nickel plated for rust resistance. Green baked enamel handles, comfortably shaped and fitted with closing catch.

AMERICAN CUTLER PATTERN HEDGE SHEARS

A new Wiss Hedge Clipper of clean, modern, and unusually handsome design, featuring rugged strength and handling comfort. The special handle alignment in parallel contributes to the ease of use by permitting the hands and wrist to operate in their most natural positions.

No. 8-A is made with one serrated blade that prevents slipping. No. 9-A is made with two knife edges which provide unmatched ease of operation. The bottom blade is notched for cutting heavy twigs. Both are recommended for maximum hedge trimming efficiency as well as for the toughest cutting.

NO. 218 LONG-HANDLE HEDGE SHEARS

Regular 8-inch hedge shears blades, fitted to extra-long (21-inch) hickory handles. Overall length 31". Designed to fill the need for a tool to trim high hedges, lilac bushes, forsythia, and similar shrubs. The extra leverage permits cutting even tough branches at the very points and at distances normally beyond reach. Bottom blade serrated and notched.

Blades only 61/2 inches long and weight little more than half that of standard hedge shears yet with splendid cutting efficiency. WHY WISS GARDEN TOOLS ARE BEST

For more than a century Wiss Household and Industrial Shears and Scissors have been the first choice of home and professional users. All of the skill that experience has developed in these fields is used in the design and manufacture of Wiss Garden Shears. The operations described below require expert craftsmanship and extra time, but they make Wiss Garden Tools a standard against which all others are judged.

Hot drop-forging gives to fine steel the qualities of durability and lasting sharpness to a degree not obtainable by any other method of fabrication. Except where otherwise specified, all Wiss Garden Shears are hot drop-forged of high carbon cutlery steel. This method of manufacturing is omitted only where special design makes it impossible to use, as in the manufacture of the vertical action grass shears, the flower holding shears, and anvil pruning shears.

Hardening and tempering by means of scientifically controlled heat treating assure that opposing blades are of correct and equal hardness. Blades of unequal hardness will cease to cut after brief usage and can never be repaired.

Grinding is a skill which is attained only after many years of experience. Some Wiss craftsmen have been employed by J. Wiss & Sons Co. for more than fifty years. Over 25% of the total force has an employment record of 25 years or more.

The bolt is important because the lasting adjustment of the blade depends upon its efficiency. In Wiss Hedge Shears the bolts are oversize for added strength, threaded into one blade and secured firmly with a lock nut. In other Wiss tools the bolt is placed as dictated by careful research, exactly where it will contribute most to cutting power and ease of operation. Examples of this are to be found in anvil and professional pruning shears and in vertical action grass shears.

Hand adjustment guarantees the proper stress of each blade against the other to provide perfect cutting at every point the full length of the blade. Every pair of Wiss Garden Shears is hand adjusted and hand edged to give that extra efficiency for which Wiss products have long been noted.

Design supremacy stems from a combination of experience and the Wiss program of research and experiment. By comparing Wiss products with others, even the novice can recognize their easier cutting, better balance, ruggedness, and ease of handling under all conditions.

Sell Wiss Garden Shears for their quality which means satisfaction to the user. Remind consumers that best results and greatest enjoyment in gardening can only be attained with the aid of tools which will accomplish perfectly the tasks for which they are intended.
