## Directions for the Use of Hair-Thinning Shears:

Take a lock of hair between the fingers. Spread it well and cut, holding the shears at right angles to the hair.

When the cut is completed, open the scissors and withdraw them. Do not pull the shears through the hair while the shears are in a closed position.

Cuts should be started near the scalp and repeated at regular intervals toward the ends of the hair. The intervals are determined entirely by the thickness of the hair and the amount it is desirable to remove. In this manner all of the hair may be trimmed without reducing the length.

After using hair-thinning shears, comb the hair carefully to remove the cut hairs.

Wiss hair-thinning shears are fully guaranteed to be free of defects in workmanship or material.

Because of their unusual construction, they are adjusted more tightly than regular shears and scissors. Do not loosen screw.
